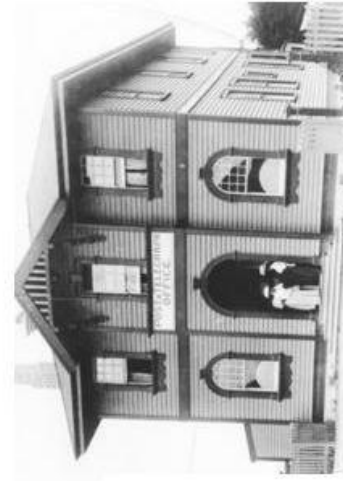

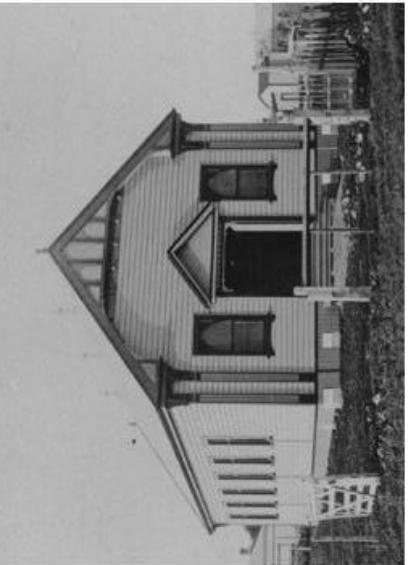
ARMISTICE DAY – MORRINSVILLE IN 1918

11am on the November 11th 2018

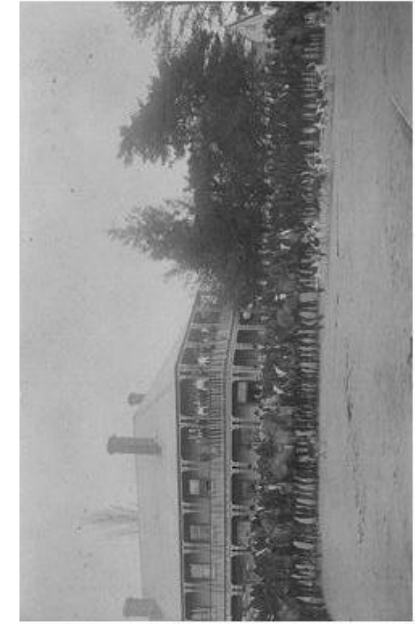
- Meet outside the Nottingham Castle on Studholme Street.
